Founded on October 1, 1946, Moldova State University (USM) is the first public higher education institution with national university status in the Republic of Moldova.

Its multidisciplinary curriculum stands out for its diversity, encompassing 11 faculties, 120 bachelor's and master's programs, 6 dual degree programs, 4 doctoral schools, and 11 research institutes.
